## Health & Safety Guidelines

In consideration of the health and safety of visitors and our campus community, we expect Family Weekend attendees to be up to date with COVID-19 vaccination, if eligible. Any visitor who is ineligible or has a medical or religious exemption must mask indoors at all times when on campus. We expect visitors to stay off campus if they have any symptoms of illness and to mask if they develop any symptoms while on campus. We expect visitors to mask at all times or stay off campus if they are a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days.
